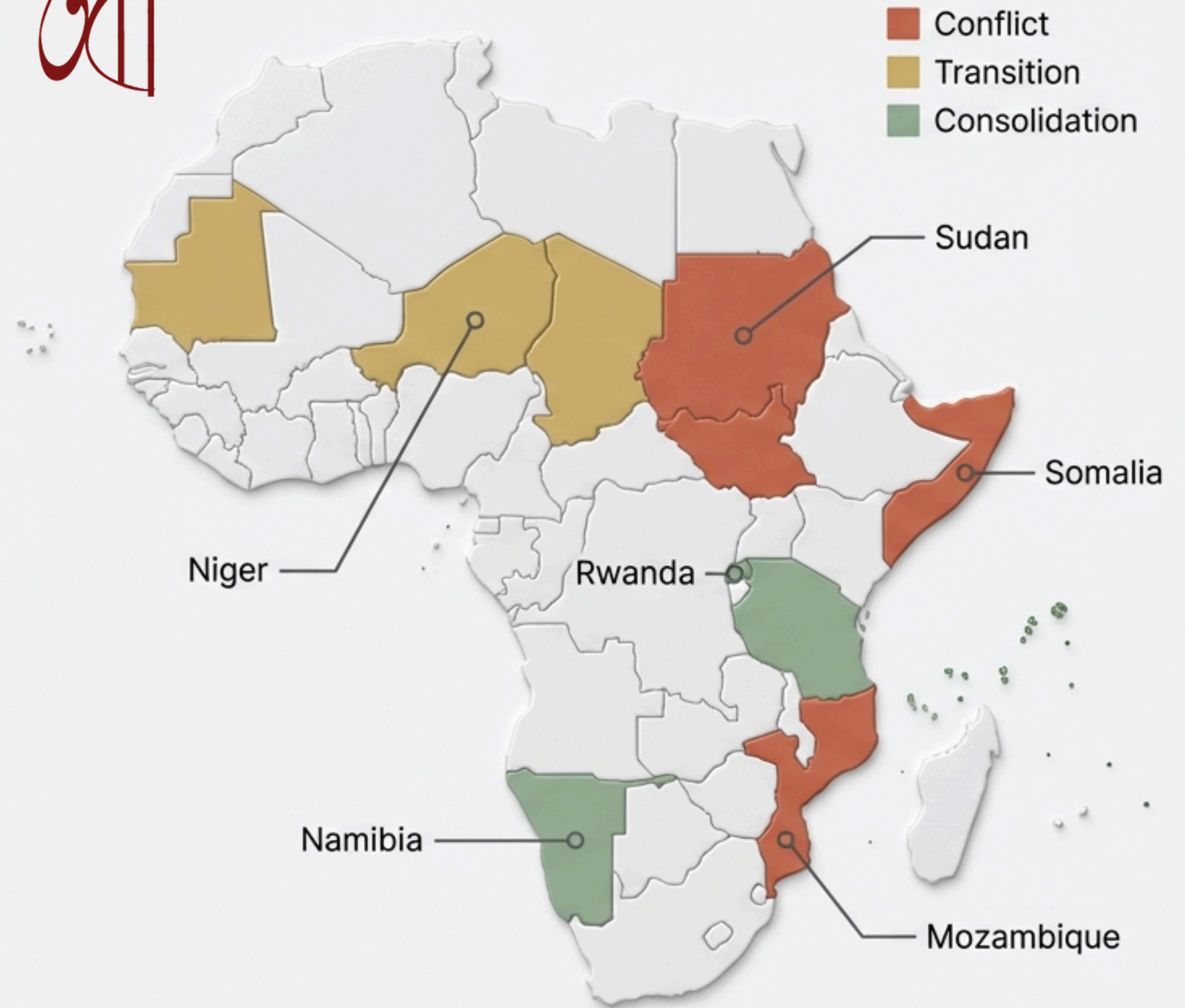

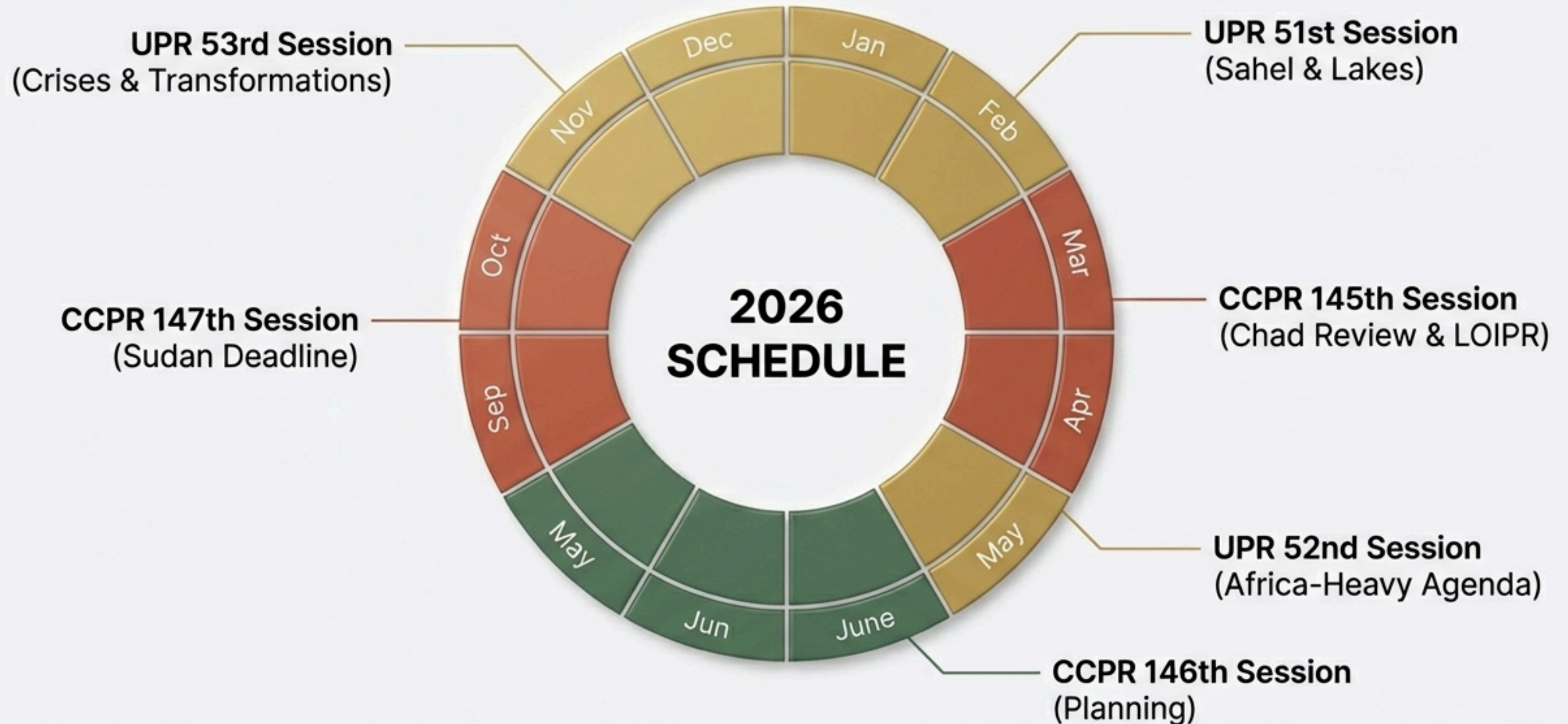
2026 Executive Context

- **The Context:** A pivotal year for international law in Africa, operating under a UN “liquidity crisis” affecting resources.
- **The Landscape:** Reviews cover a complex spectrum from open armed conflict to sensitive political transitions.
- **The Mechanisms:** A simultaneous density of schedules for both the Universal Universal Periodic Review (UPR) and the Human Rights Committee (CCPR).

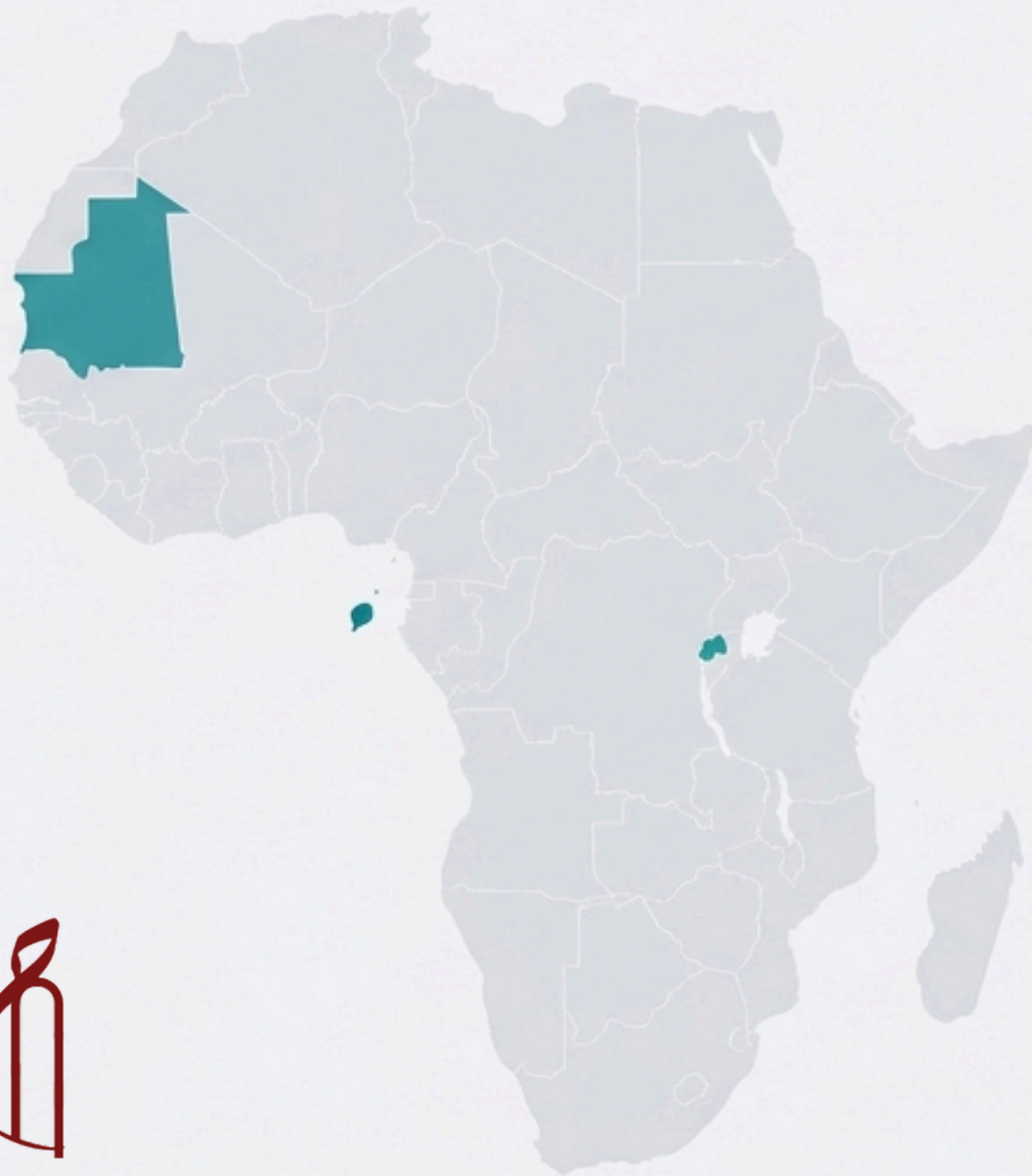




The 2026 Cycle of Review



Session 51: The Sahel & The Great Lakes



Mauritania

- **Focus:** Legacy of Slavery (Implementation effectiveness vs. Law enactment)
- **Civic Space:** "National Symbols" law and journalists
- **Justice:** Death penalty abolition and "Right to Life"

Rwanda

- **The Contradiction:** Economic progress vs. Civil rights criticism
- **Key Issues:** Freedom of memory, M23 support in DRC, Reprisal fears

Sao Tome & Principe

- **Focus:** Economic rights (Health/Education), Judicial independence, Corruption



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Session 52: The 'Africa-Heavy' Agenda



Security & Transition

- **Niger:** Testing mechanisms with 'transitional authorities'; Counter-terrorism impact.
- **Somalia:** State-building amidst conflict; Child recruitment; Justice reform.



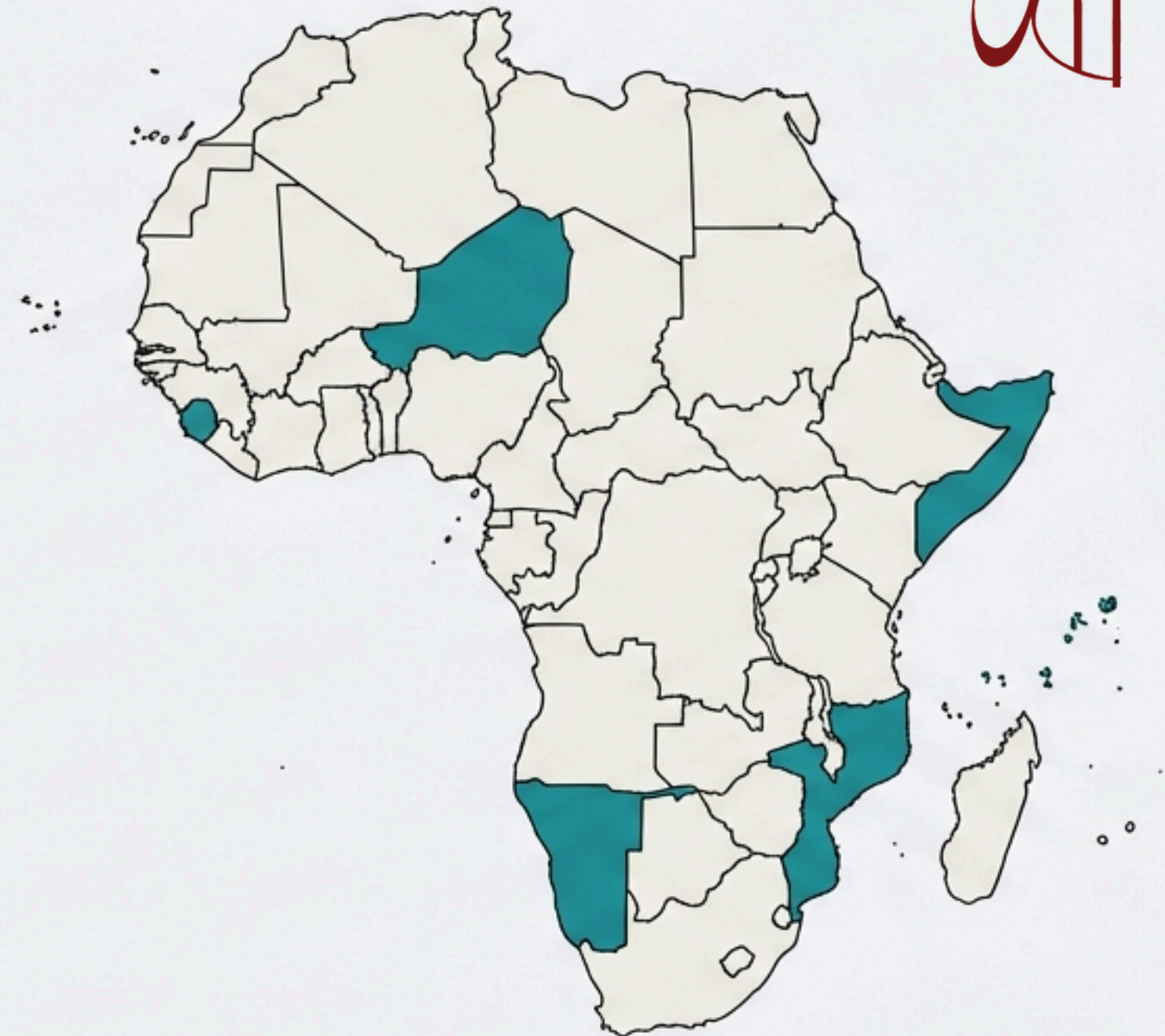
Resources & Conflict

- **Mozambique:** The Cabo Delgado conflict; Gas discovery impacts; Community rights.



Development & Rights

- **Seychelles:** Climate diplomacy & Blue Economy.
- **Namibia:** Land distribution (San people).
- **Sierra Leone:** Death penalty abolition progress.



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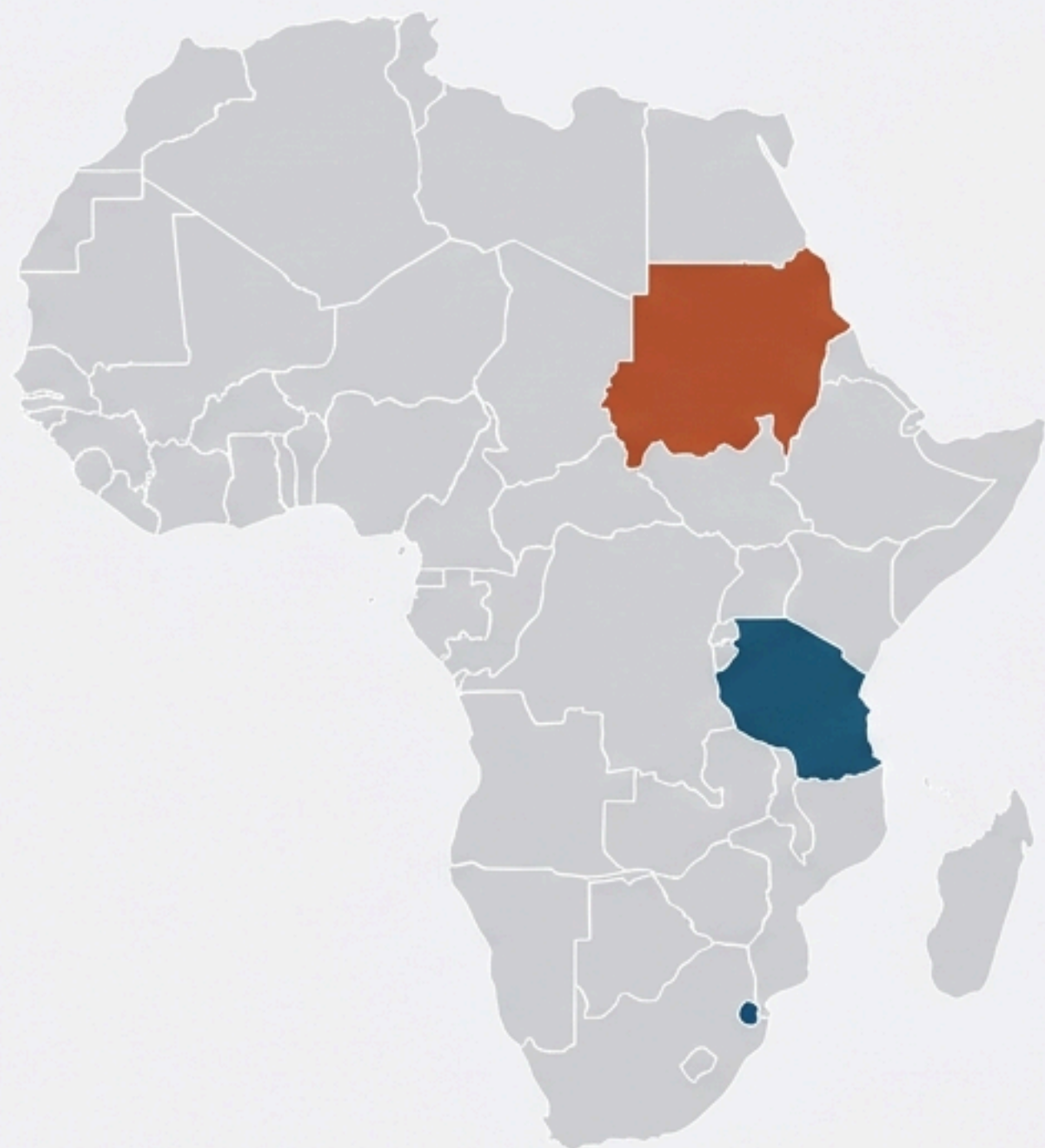
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Session 53: Crises and Transformations



Sudan (High Priority)

- **Context:** Devastating armed conflict since April 2023.
- **Key Question:** Who represents the state?
- **Accountability:** War crimes, ethnic cleansing (Darfur), Famine & Humanitarian access.

Eswatini

- **Context:** Africa's only absolute monarchy.
- **Focus:** Bans on political parties, electoral reform, women's legal status.

Tanzania

- **Context:** Assessment of new leadership.
- **Focus:** Opening of civic space; Maasai land rights in Ngorongoro.

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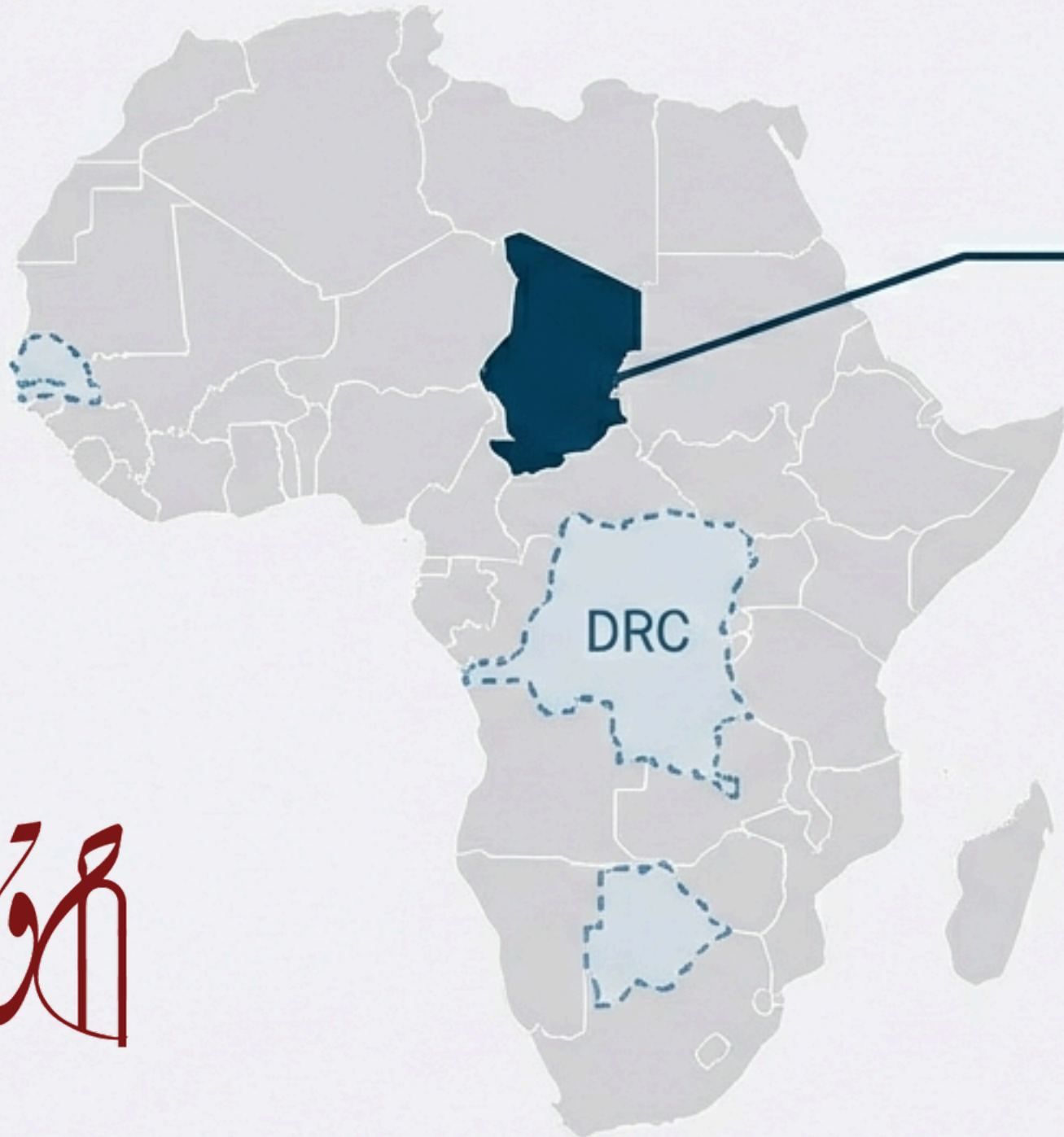
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CCPR 145th Session (March): Chad Under the Microscope



CHAD (Full Interactive Review)

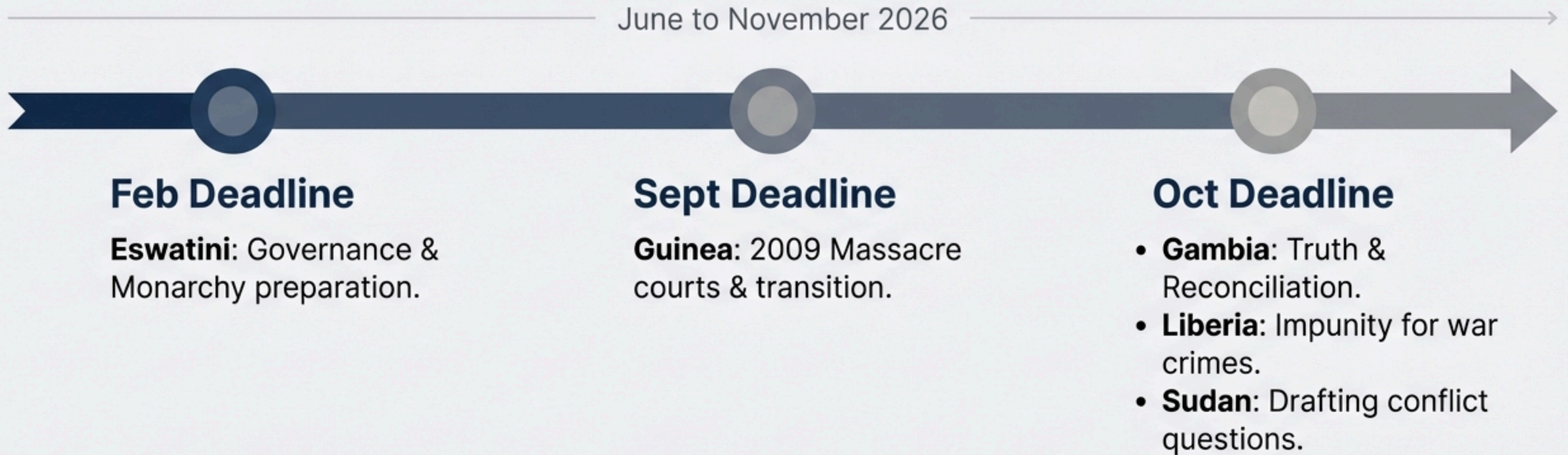
- Critical transitional phase examination.
- Suppression of Oct 2022 protests.
- Counter-terrorism in Lake Chad Basin.

The Planning Phase (LOIPR)

- DRC: Violence in the East & Elections.
- Senegal: Post-election freedoms.
- Botswana: Follow-up on urgent recommendations.

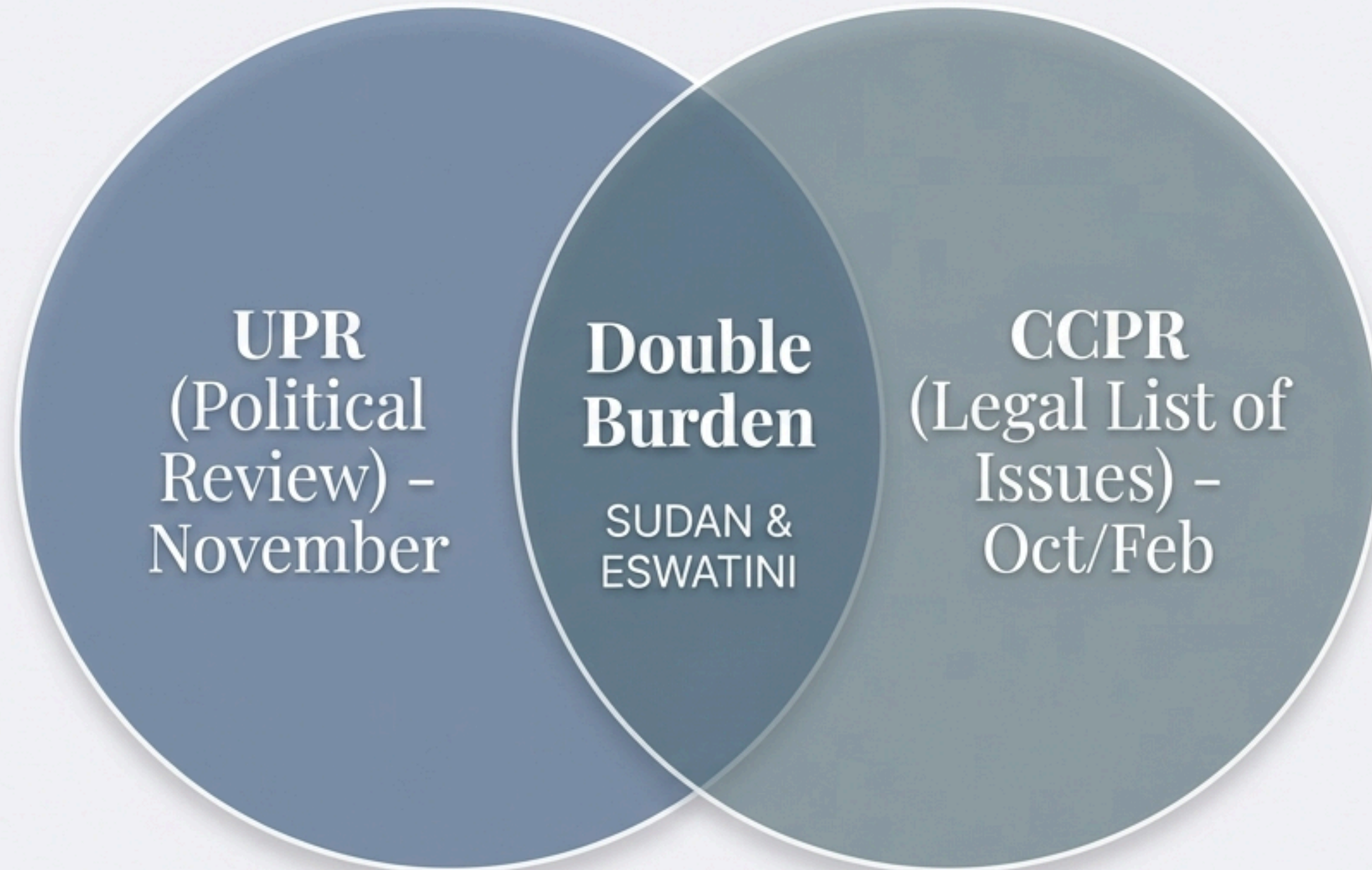


Paving the Way for 2027-2028 (LOIPR)



The Committee adopts Lists of Issues (LOIPR) to set the future agenda.

Structural Challenges: The Double Review Burden



The Convergence:

- **Sudan** and **Eswatini** face deadlines for both mechanisms in late 2026.
- **Challenge:** Extreme logistical pressure on diplomatic missions.
- **Opportunity:** Unified advocacy for civil society via integrated shadow reports.



Trends Shaping the 2026 Landscape



The Liquidity Crisis

Lack of UN funds may reduce translation services and force hybrid meetings.

Risks the quality of dialogue for African states where in-person engagement is vital.



Simplified Reporting

Shift toward the Committee drafting questions (LOIPR) to break the cycle of non-reporting (e.g., Congo, Senegal).

Proactive agenda setting.



Regional Synergy

Need to align UN recommendations with the African Commission (Banjul), particularly for high-pressure reviews of Sudan and Somalia.
